



The 2010 Red Fire Farm Scarecrow Contest

HOW TO ENTER: Enter your scarecrow(s) for judging and display. Entries will be judged on design, originality and creativity.

1 – **CREATE:** Choose your category and make an awesome, durable scarecrow. Contact us if you'd like to use some straw for your scarecrow, we can give you some, limited availability.

2 – **LABEL:** Attach a clear, weather-hardy label to your scarecrow with

- A. Your name
- B. Your phone number
- C. Your address
- D. Your e-mail
- E. Name and story of your scarecrow

3 – **DELIVER:** Contact the farm to find out where it's okay to put your scarecrow. Bring entries to the Red Fire Farm barn at 7 Carver St., Granby, MA. Set up your scarecrow outdoors around the farmstand. The farm reserves the right to move entries around as needed. **Competing scarecrows must be in place by Saturday October 9th, 2010 ~ the day of the Cider Pressing Party. Earlier is better! Don't forget a label!**

PRIZES include:

1st - a Fall Harvest Gift Basket of our produce and two large carving pumpkins

2nd - two large carving pumpkins and 10 bulbs of garlic to keep away the vampires

3rd - one large carving pumpkin

Other honorable scarecrows will be mentioned in the Red Fire Reader newsletter.

Winners will be announced by the week of October 18th in the farm's weekly e-mail. Come by the farm to pick up your prizes.

DISPLAY AND RECOVERY: Scarecrows are displayed outdoors and should be able to survive weathering until after Halloween. If the farm deems any scarecrows unworthy or inappropriate for the public, we reserve the right to remove them at any time. The farm is not responsible for lost or stolen items. If you want to recover any materials from your scarecrow, please pick them up in the week after Halloween until 12 noon Friday November 5th. We will clear away any scarecrows left after noon on the 5th.
