

Some households are currently receiving emergency SNAP allotments during the COVID-19 emergency.

If you receive emergency SNAP allotments during the COVID-19 emergency, you can choose to use your emergency SNAP allotment to pay for a CSA share that costs more than your regular monthly SNAP and HIP benefit allotment. If you choose this option, your CSA payment will be scheduled on the 5<sup>th</sup> of each month during the COVID-19 emergency.

Emergency allotments are temporary. DTA will notify you when the emergency allotments will end.

If your CSA costs more than your regular SNAP and HIP benefit allotment, when emergency allotments end, your SNAP benefits will no longer cover the full cost of the CSA share. At that time, you must choose to either cancel your CSA agreement or pay the remainder of the CSA share's balance each month to the vendor using another payment method. Please choose one option now.
